Details for the Defence Ward's Scholarship at BML Munjal University

The Defence Ward's Scholarship is for the wards of serving and retired armed forces officers and other ranks.

The services that have been included are the Indian Army, Indian Navy and Indian Air Force.

Eligibility:

- Admission Eligibility Criteria at BMU must be met and Admission Process as laid out must be completed successfully to be eligible for this scholarship.
- There will be no rank restriction for this scholarship.
- This scholarship is admissible for only two members per family.
- This scholarship is also applicable for lateral and migration candidates.

Scholarship:

In an effort to show gratitude to and honor our valiant armed forces, 10% of all scholarships being offered by BMU are reserved for wards of serving and retired armed forces officers and other ranks, who are eligible as per admission process defined by the University.

Duration of the Scholarship:

One to five years*

*This will depend upon the duration of the course being pursued by the applicant and as approved by the competent authority of the University. The duration is strictly subject to further terms and conditions.

Documents Required:

Following documents in the respective category are mandatorily required to be submitted/uploaded to the Admission Portal by the applicant for applying under Armed Forces Scholarship at BMU:

- Service Certificate to be issued by the respective Head Office in case of serving personnel in the prescribed format
- PPO/Discharge Certificate/Book (mandatory for retired/widows/widowers/wards applying)
- Death Certificate of relevant Armed Forces personnel, if applicable
- Certificate of Gallantry Award, if applicable

Please Note:

- Armed Forces Scholarship is not applicable in addition to any other scholarship that the applicant may be eligible for as laid out by the University, limited to the total amount of tuition fees of the University.
- Scholarship will be awarded to the student only after the verification of the original documents. In case the student is not able to provide the documents within the stipulated time as prescribed by the university, the offer could be withdrawn.
- Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the above criteria and the interview performance at the sole discretion of the Admissions Committee.
- Scholarships are not guaranteed to all the candidates fulfilling the criteria.
- There are a limited number of scholarships which will be awarded on a firstcome-first-served basis.
- All scholarships will be awarded at the sole discretion of the Selection Committee only after a final offer of admission is made and accepted.
- Terms and Conditions apply to maintain scholarship, students will have to
 - Be among the top 20% of the batch (for School of Management), top 40% of the batch (for School of Engineering and Technology, School of Economics and Commerce, and School of Law)
 - b. Maintain a CGPA of 7 or above
 - c. Attain above 80% attendance, and
 - d. Face no disciplinary action throughout the entire programme.
- If at any stage, it is found that an applicant has concealed, suppressed, distorted any information/ fact(s) which would have rendered him ineligible for the admission and/or ineligible for benefit of Fee/Scholarship or applicant has been admitted and/or benefit of Fee/ Scholarship/ EDB has been awarded by default by the University, then the admission and/or benefit of Fee/ Scholarship/ EDB will stand cancelled and action will be taken as per law of the land.
- In case of any matter not covered here and for interpretation of any content of this proposal, the decision of the competent authority of the University shall be final and binding on all concerned.
- The Policy is effective from the academic session of 2018-19 and has been extended to academic sessions starting in 2019-2020, and 2020-2021.
