FASHION CRAVE

During the fest week, SMC and UDAAN held a fashion show, the theme for the same was "CREATING AN IMPACT". Teams from multiple universities come in to participate and engage in this interesting and fun event. BOXING COMPETITION

Boxing (also known as "Western boxing" or "pugilism") is a combat sport in which two people, usually wearing protective gloves and other protective equipment such as hand wraps and mouthguards, throw punches at each other for a predetermined amount of time in a boxing ring.

DEADLIFT COMPETITION

Deadlift, the powerlifting athlete grasps the loaded bar that's resting on the platform floor. They pull the weights off the floor and then assume a standing erect position – the knees must be locked, the shoulders back, and the weights held in the athlete's grip. At the referee's signal, the athlete returns the bar to the floor. The Deadlift Championships is a competition featuring the strength of athletes from all weight categories.



HACKED

A technical hackathon focused on promoting innovation, networking, and ideation for upcoming technologies in our continuously growing industry. Students and attendees of the 67th Milestone attended the hackathon, which was a 24-hour event, aimed at hosting upcoming engineers, developers, mobile and web hackers to promote leadership and ideas among our participants.



CLAY DAY

Clay Day, event intended to rekindle the good old days and get you in touch with your roots. The event involved a competition between the students, encouraging healthy competition.





LOVESTRUCK PHOTOGRAPHY

This was a portrait smoke bombs photography contest having a live photography session in campus with the help of smoke bombs provided by us.



FINE ARTS MARATHON

It was a two-stage competition in which the contestants had to draw a real object using sketching pencils on paper in the first stage. In the second stage they were instructed to draw on a canvas

with the theme of Pride. Description of event (glass painting): Participants in the competition need to use glass paints to create drawings on a glass slab or acrylic sheet.

Participants in the competition needed to use glass paints to create drawings on a glass slab or acrylic sheet.




MONEY MUFFIN

The goal of the contest was to design an autonomous robot that will follow a black line on a white background. The participants must create an autonomous vehicle (ROBOT). The bot must be able to detect black line and follow it.



ROBO WARS

Are you a Tech enthusiast? Are you interested in wars? If yes, just imagine! Two robots clashing with each other, destroying, and rushing to win the throne. Would you like to be that winning king? Then, gear up your robots and fly the sparks.





ROBO RACE

"Life is a race...if you don't run fast...you will be like a broken anda! Okay, so you think your bot is fast but is it fast enough? Robo race is your best chance to find out, we had the country's quickest bots compete for their supremacy.





THEATRE PHANTAMONICA

A theatrical competition in which teams from several colleges portrayed and narrated a tale through an act developed by each university. A stage for students to use their acting abilities to express their opinions, feelings, and problems concerning a topic of choice.

BEAT THE STREET

A group dance competition in which groups from several institutions presented their synchronized performances, leaving the audience in amazement with their outstanding dance skills and power-packed performances. RUN FOR PRIDE




AERIAL DRONES RACING
