Report on Five-Day Faculty Development Programme (FDP)
**“Innovation and the University Entrepreneurial
Ecosystem”**

Organised by: Institute of Innovation & Entrepreneurship (I2E), BML Munjal University,
in collaboration with CTLD-BMU and the Association of Indian Universities

Dates: 6th – 10th April 2026
Mode: Hybrid (Online & Offline)
Participants: 26 Registered Participants

1. Introduction

BML Munjal University (BMU) and the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), in collaboration with the Centre for Teaching, Learning and Development (CTLD), Institute of Innovation and Entrepreneurship (I2E)-BML Munjal University (I2E-BMU), Atal Community Innovation Centre (ACIC-BMU Foundation), and Institution’s Innovation Council (IIC-BMU), organised a five-day FDP on **“Innovation and the University Entrepreneurial Ecosystem,”** supported by AIU–BML Munjal University Academic and Administrative Development Centre. The programme was delivered by the Institute of Innovation and Entrepreneurship (I2E) at BMU and aimed to strengthen faculty understanding of innovation-driven education and entrepreneurship.

The FDP focused on enhancing the capacity for innovation-driven teaching and research while fostering an entrepreneurial mindset among faculty and students. Through keynote sessions, expert talks, workshops, and experiential activities, participants explored strategies to integrate entrepreneurship into academia and co-create a roadmap for innovation excellence

2. Objectives

- To enhance awareness of innovation and entrepreneurship within the higher education ecosystem
- To foster an entrepreneurial mindset among faculty and educators
- To provide insights into national and global innovation ecosystems, policies, and institutional frameworks
- To enable the integration of experiential learning and entrepreneurial pedagogy into higher education curricula

- To strengthen the capacity of educators to mentor student-led innovation and startup initiatives

3. Programme Highlights

The FDP was structured across five days, covering key themes aligned with innovation and entrepreneurship in higher education. It began with Innovation Foundations, including sessions on Innovation in the Modern Economy, Role of IIC in HEIs, Emerging Innovation Opportunities in Academia, and Building Innovation Ecosystems.

The second day focused on Building an Entrepreneurial Mindset, with sessions on Entrepreneurial Mindset Development and From Ideas to Impact: Experiential Project Building, complemented by a field visit to ACIC and I2E, providing hands-on exposure to innovative ecosystems.

The third day addressed Innovation in Education, covering the Indian Startup Ecosystem, a Panel Discussion on Scaling Campus Innovations, NEP 2020 and Innovation Reforms, and the 5P Philosophy and Entrepreneurial Competency Framework for structured project development.

The fourth day emphasised Experience and Scaling Innovation, including Case Study of BMU's I2E Journey, Faculty–Student Startup Success Stories, Entrepreneurial Pedagogy, and a session on The Rise of Entrepreneurial Universities in India.

The final day focused on Innovation Roadmap and Global Perspectives, featuring sessions on Collaborative Research Projects, Implementation Trajectories of Entrepreneurial Universities (International Session), and AI-Driven Innovation in Universities: From Research Labs to Startups, followed by the closing ceremony.

Overall, the FDP integrated expert lectures, panel discussions, experiential learning sessions, and field exposure, ensuring a comprehensive and practice-oriented learning experience.

4. Key Outcomes

- Enhanced understanding of innovative ecosystems within higher education
- Exposure to best practices in entrepreneurship education and institutional innovation
- Development of project ideas through experiential learning approaches
- Strengthened academic collaboration and interdisciplinary engagement
- Improved capacity of faculty to integrate innovation and entrepreneurship into teaching

5. Conclusion

The FDP concluded successfully with active participation and engagement from all attendees. The programme achieved its objectives of strengthening innovation-driven teaching and fostering an entrepreneurial mindset among educators. Certificates were awarded to participants upon successful completion.

a) Eminent Speakers and Key Session Highlights

The FDP featured a distinguished lineup of national and international experts, enriching the programme with diverse perspectives on innovation and entrepreneurship in higher education.

b) International Expert

Prof. Dr. Aard J. Groen

A globally renowned scholar in entrepreneurship and valorization, Prof. Groen delivered an insightful session on “Implementation Trajectories of Becoming an Entrepreneurial University: Case-Based Perspectives.” His talk highlighted global best practices of global commercialization pathways and strategies for transforming universities into innovation-driven entrepreneurial ecosystems.

c) Leading Academic and Policy Experts

Prof. Sankalp Pratap (IIT Bombay)

Delivered a session on “Emerging Innovation Opportunities in Academia,” emphasizing interdisciplinary research, innovation-led teaching, and the evolving role of higher education institutions in fostering entrepreneurship.

Dr. Dipan Sahu (MoE Innovation Cell, AICTE)

Provided deep insights into the Innovation Cell (IIC) framework, highlighting its role in fostering innovation culture, institutional ecosystems, and structured support mechanisms across Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in India.

d) Other Notable Experts:

Dr. M. H. Bala Subrahmanya (IISc Bangalore)

Delivered a thought-provoking session on “The Rise of Entrepreneurial Universities in India: Evidence, Challenges, and Opportunities.” His talk focused on institutional transformation and the increasing importance of innovation-driven models in higher education.

Prof. Shyam Menon (Vice Chancellor, BMU)

In his keynote address, he emphasized the role of innovation in the modern economy and the need for universities to evolve as hubs of knowledge creation, entrepreneurship, and societal impact.
