Admission Policy- M.A. Public Policy

1. Programme Offered

Two-Year Master of Arts in Public Policy Programme (MAPP).

2. Eligibility Criteria

Bachelor's degree in any discipline (3/4/5-year duration) with a minimum requirement of 60%. Work experience is not a prerequisite.

3. Standardized Tests for Admission:

MAPP entrance exam (involving two components-MCQs and subjective part)

4. Admission Process

The following process will be followed for admission to the MAPP programme.

- Applicants will submit the online application on the BMU's Admission Portal.
- Applicants will submit the duly filled application form along with all the requisite documents like Class X Marksheet, Class XII Marksheet, Graduation Marksheet and other Certificates for the Extra-curricular activities, Score Card of the standardized national test score etc. The application fee is to be paid online.
- The shortlisted candidates will be invited to appear for MAPP entrance exam which include General MCQs + Public Policy specific MCQs + Subjective Public Policy essay+ Subjective Statement of Purpose essay
- Next round includes an interview. Students are evaluated on their critical thinking, problem-solving, collaboration, and communication skills.

5. Fees

An application fee of ₹2000 is payable at the time of submission of the online application form.

6. Facility of Day Scholars

No option for day scholars as it is a two-year fully residential programme.
