Preamble

BML Munjal University follows Scholarship policy designed to recognize academic merit among the diverse pool of talent across India. Our policy fosters a culture of diversity and inclusion that acknowledges the unique strengths of different individuals.

1. Scope

The policy document covers the scholarship details of the following postgraduate and undergraduate programmes:

- MAPP
- MBA
- BBA/BBA (Hons.)
- B. Com/B. Com (Hons.)
- IBM
- B.A LL.B (Hons.)
- B.B.A LL.B (Hons.)
- LL. B
- B.A. (Hons.) LS
- B.Tech., comprising of following branches.
 - Computer Science & Engineering
 - Electronics and Computer Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering

2. Grant of Scholarships

Within the overall limit of the total intake, the number of grants will be aligned to the intake each year and the ceiling for Merit Scholarships will be in accordance with Table-1

3. Haryana Domicile Scholarships

- 3.1 The provision for Haryana Domicile is as per the Haryana Private Universities Act. Of the total applications, 25% of seats for admissions at BMU are reserved for students of the State of Haryana, out of which 10% of seats are reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Castes of the State.
- 3.2 25% of students who are admitted under Haryana Domicile Category are eligible for full or partial fee concession. Below are categories for fee concessions:
- 3.2.1. One-fifth of the twenty-five per cent shall be granted full fee concession.
 - 3.2.2. Two-fifth of the twenty-five per cent shall be granted fifty per cent fee concession.
 - 3.2.3. The balance two-fifth of the twenty-five per cent shall be granted twenty-five per cent fee concession.
- 3.3 The Haryana Domicile Scholarship will continue in the following years as per the provisions of the Act.
- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of the previous academic year.
 - A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
 - There should be no disciplinary action against the student.

4 Merit Scholarships

- 4.1 BMU provides two categories of Merit Scholarships.
- 4.1.1. Dean's Scholarships to recognise exceptional academic merit.
 - 4.1.2. Programme Scholarships to encourage students who have diverse strengths to aspire to an education of a high standard.
- 4.2 The Dean's Scholarships are equivalent to 100% and 75% of tuition fees and are based on qualifying merit. These are limited to the intake of various programmes in the following manner:
- 2% in BBA/BBA(H) programme
 - 3% in MBA and B.Tech. CSE programme
 - 6% in B.Com/B.Com(H), BA LLB(H)/BBA LLB(H) and Integrated BBA-MBA programme
 - 9% in B.Tech. ME & ECE programme
 - 11% in BA(H) LS programme
 - 14% in LLB programme

- 34% in MAPP programme

The same has been accorded in Table-2.

4.3 Dean's Scholarships are granted for the entire duration of the programme, subject to meeting the following eligibility criteria:

- A minimum CGPA of 8.5 academic year without any backlog. If the student does not achieve the desired CGPA, the Dean's Scholarship will stand revoked without the option for the Scholarship to be reinstated. However, such students would be eligible for the Programme Scholarship as per its terms and conditions.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no type of disciplinary action against the student.

4.4 Programme Scholarships is equivalent to 50%, 25% & 10% of the Tuition Fees, based upon the academic merit. These are limited to the intake at various programmes in the following manner:

- 15% in MBA programme
- 19% in B.Tech. CSE programme
- 21% in BBA/BBA(H) programme
- 23% in B.Com/B.Com(H) programme
- 24% in Integrated BBA-MBA programme
- 26% in LLB programme
- 29% in BA LLB(H)/BBA LLB(H) programme
- 35% in BA(H) LS programme
- 43% in B.Tech. ME & ECE programme
- 61% in MAPP programme

The same has been accorded in Table-2.

4.5 From the second year onwards, Programme Scholarships shall be awarded and/or continued strictly on the basis of the student's position in the merit list of the respective programme, determined by the CGPA at the end of the preceding academic year. The number of scholarships under each category (50%, 25%, and 10% of tuition fee) shall be limited to the percentage of students specified for each programme, as outlined in Table 2, and shall be calculated on the basis of the total number of students actually admitted in the cohort. Scholarships will be allocated

in descending order of merit until the prescribed percentage for each category is fulfilled, subject to the student meeting the minimum eligibility criteria given below.

- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of the previous academic year.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no disciplinary action against the student.

Terms & Conditions

- Scholarships are applicable on tuition fees only.
- Scholarships are initially awarded for the first academic year at the University.
- Meeting the minimum eligibility criteria will not automatically ensure the grant of a scholarship to any student.
- The renewal of a Merit Scholarship will be strictly based upon the rank in the merit list in the Programme as finalised by the Admissions and Scholarship Committee.
- In the first year, to be eligible for a scholarship, a student should have received an offer in terms of all academic criteria specified by the school. A Scholarship once offered will be withdrawn in case the offer is not accepted within the stipulated time given for accepting the offer of admission.
- Scholarships are not applicable to the International Immersion programmes.

- Scholarships will be awarded based on criteria at the sole discretion of the Admission and Scholarship Committee, respectively.
- The Principal or designated administrative head of any school in India may be invited to nominate Class 12 students at the school for Merit Scholarship, and such nominations will be fast-tracked to the Admission and Scholarship Committee for grant of Scholarship on a priority basis. They can nominate 2 students; any further nominations beyond 2 students can be considered at the discretion of the admissions and scholarship committee. Their scholarship shall be upgraded by one level above the existing slab. Such Scholarships will be granted based on the merit criteria and availability of scholarship seats.
- The scholarship for the applicants coming from SAARC countries shall be upgraded by one level above the existing slab or as per the Admission and Scholarship committee decision.
- At any point during an academic year, a student can avail the benefits from only one scholarship. In the case of a student who is eligible for more than one scholarship, the student will be considered for the scholarship offering the higher amount.
- In case the students withdraw from the degree programme, whichever semester he/she may be in, and for whatever reason, the students will be liable to return to BML Munjal University the entire scholarship/stipend awarded to them from the time they joined BML Munjal University, as per the University fee refund and other applicable rules.
- BMU reserves the right to change the governing policy at its discretion.
- Students may only benefit from one scholarship scheme at a time. If eligible for multiple, the scheme providing the higher benefit will be awarded.

Note:

- Preference for North East, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh students by announcing a separate merit list under the merit scholarship category.
- Preference for MBA applicants from technical backgrounds like B.Tech/B.E/BCA by announcing a separate merit list under the merit scholarship category.
- Applicants falling under the following categories may be eligible for consideration of a minimum fee waiver, subject to the discretion and approval of the Admissions Committee:
 - a. Siblings (including twins) applying in the same academic year
 - b. Wards of single mothers
 - c. Wards of farmers.

5. Grant Of Equity Scholarship

The University is committed to promoting equity and inclusion by extending financial support to students from economically and socially weaker sections through the Equity Scholarship. This initiative seeks to ensure equitable access to education, foster a caring and inclusive campus environment, and enable students to pursue their academic and career aspirations with dignity and confidence. It further reflects the University's commitment to embedding equity, inclusion, and social responsibility as core institutional values, while supporting the full and meaningful participation of scholarship recipients in campus life. Candidates are advised to refer to the Equity Policy for detailed information on eligibility criteria, application procedures, and the selection process.

6. Defence Ward Fee Waiver

- 6.1 To honour our valiant armed forces, children of serving/retired/ killed in action or deceased while in service, armed forces officers or personnel of the other rank, including those serving in the Indian Defence Services, and other Paramilitary forces, are given a defence waiver.
- 6.2 This is provided to the categories mentioned below:

- Indian Navy
- Indian Air Force
- Defence Security Corps
- Indian Coast Guard

Category B (Paramilitary Forces)

- BSF (Border Security Force)
- CISF (Central Industrial Security Force)
- CRPF (Central Reserve Police Force)
- ITBP (Indo-Tibetan Border Police)
- NSG (National Security Guard)
- RPF (Railway Protection Force)
- SSB (Sashastra Seema Bal)
- SPG (Special Protection Group)
- Assam Rifles
- SSF (Special Frontier Force)

6.3 A waiver of 10% of the Tuition Fees for the entire duration of the programme of study, subject to meeting the following criteria:

- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of previous academic year.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no disciplinary action against the student.

6.4 Students awarded with the Defence Fee Waiver in the first year shall be eligible for a merit-based scholarship in the subsequent year, based on the CGPA secured in the said academic year. A student can receive only one scholarship at a time in an academic year. In case the student does not maintain the required rank/CGPA for the merit scholarship, the Defence Fee Waiver will be awarded, provided the student meets the eligibility criteria mentioned above.

7 Hero Ward Fee Waiver

7.1 Students whose parents are a permanent employee with Hero Group companies – Hero MotoCorp, Hero Fincorp, Hero Future Energies, Munjal Showa Limited, Rockman Industries, Hero Cycle, Hero Enterprise, BCM Schools, Raman Munjal Vidya Mandir, BML Munjal Green Meadows School will be extended a 10% Tuition Fee Waiver for the entire duration of the programme of study, subject to meeting the following criteria:

- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of the previous academic year.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no disciplinary action against the student.

7.2 Students awarded with the Hero Ward Fee Waiver in the first year shall be eligible for a merit-based scholarship in the subsequent year, based on the CGPA secured in the said academic year. A student can receive only one scholarship at a time in an academic year. In case the student does not maintain the required rank/CGPA for the merit scholarship, the Hero Ward Fee Waiver will be awarded, provided the student meets the eligibility criteria mentioned above.

8 Sports Scholarships

8.1 Outstanding sports professionals who have received an offer of admission may be extended a Tuition Fee Waiver for the entire duration of programme of study as specified in **Annexure C**.

8.2 Students who are interested in receiving sports scholarships at BMU will need to undergo sports trials in their respective games before joining the University. The Sports Department will verify the

sports certificates of the students who successfully complete the sports trials and confirm the sports scholarship.

8.3 These scholarships are initially awarded for the first academic year and are subject to renewal on an annual basis based upon the eligibility criteria and a personal interview.

8.4 The minimum criteria to be eligible for the award of sports scholarship in the subsequent years are as follows:

- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of the previous academic year.
- For the students representing the University at the National level/State level/AIU level/Inter-University level, a minimum CGPA of 6.00 will be considered.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 75% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no disciplinary action against the student.
- If a student, under any circumstances such as injury or medical issues, has not represented BMU in sports after admission, it is essential to submit medical evidence to the concerned authority. In such cases, these students will maintain all the scholarship criteria applicable for academic (merit) scholarship.

9 Internal Referral Programme

9.1 Candidates who have completed their undergraduate programme from BMU and are interested in pursuing an MBA and LLB programme at BMU may be granted a waiver of 25% on the tuition fee for the first year of the programme, though the same shall not be claimed as a privilege.

9.2 Referral candidates who are siblings (not cousins) of either BMU Alumni or students currently pursuing a UG/PG programme at BMU shall be granted a waiver of 25% on the tuition fee for the first year of the programme.

9.3 For wards of the employees of BMU, there shall be 50% fee waiver on the tuition fee of the programme enrolled for the entire duration, subject to meeting the following criteria:

- A student should have a minimum CGPA of 7.00 at the end of the previous academic year.
- A student should have maintained a minimum of 80% attendance across all courses in each semester/module in the previous year(s).
- There should be no disciplinary action against the student.

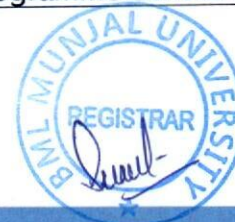

To promote the culture of Sports in BMU and as an incentive to international / national sportspersons, BMU offers Tuition Fee Waivers based on the achievements of outstanding sportspersons as under:

Proficiency Level	Net Benefit
International Level Medallist/Participant	100% Tuition Fee waiver
National level medallist including in CBSE national competition	75% Tuition Fee waiver
National level participant including in CBSE national competition/State Level Medallist including in CBSE zonal competition	50% Tuition Fee waiver
State Level Participant including in CBSE zonal competition	25% Tuition Fee waiver

Where the following definitions shall hold:

- International level applies to competitions approved by Govt. of India/Indian Olympic Association/National Sports Federation.
- National level applies to competitions approved by Govt. of India/Indian Olympic Association/ National Sports Federation.
- State level applies to competitions approved by State Olympic Association/State Sports Association.

To be eligible for the aforesaid scholarship, the candidate should fulfil the following additional criteria:

- Candidate must undergo sports trials and pass physical fitness and sports proficiency test/s to the satisfaction of BMU Sports Office.
- The student must represent BMU Team in the sport of specialisation on annual basis at the University as called upon to be eligible for continuation of scholarship.
- Scholarships will be considered only for the sports offered at BML Munjal University i.e., Athletics, Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Chess, Cricket, Football, Kabaddi, Lawn Tennis, Martial Arts (Judo/Karate/Taekwondo), Pool, Powerlifting, Table Tennis, Volleyball and Weightlifting.
